6 Month Forecast Reading Sample

INTRODUCTION

I have included both progressed placements and aspects with, and in combination to, transiting aspects to the natal placements to effectively foresee a probability for opportunities for you in the near future, the following six months in to the year 2017.

Questions regarding the next months included:

- traveling abroad through employment for the next year
- seriously pursuing a writing career; writing/publishing a book
- Anything to be wary of, in terms of potential setbacks or obstacle to be mindful of

Christine, your natal chart was a pleasure to work with, as I have little experience in delineating charts with such a dramatically skewed MidHeaven, due to the extreme latitude of your birth place. What happens when the first breath is taken so very close to the northern or southern tip of the earth is quite extraordinary; the houses become dramatically large near the MidHeaven and IC and consequently quite smaller the nearer you move to the horizon, or vice versa, as to reflect the sphere of our planet. I use the word above, 'skewed' in an effort to indicate more of a diagonal line, as opposed to a straight line. Thank you for this opportunity.

You informed me to your basic knowledge of astrology, even as far as studying your chart. This is impressive, as well as quite admirable. It is always inspiring to me to know that those who are not necessarily studying charts, still hold enough curiosity to look deeper. Your natal placements will serve you your entire lifetime, and beyond, it is but a roadmap to your both your primal and truest potential.

I will therefore use astrological terms, and please, if anything at all is unclear, please do copy/paste the section to have me explain in more appropriate detail. When creating these write-ups, I do try to keep in mind that you will read at a later date and not have me there as a direct reference or guide. This is frustrating for both of us, even if in dissimilar ways. I would hate for you to presume something I had not intended by the use of a word or two; it would be a great disservice to both you and the art of astrology. So, please, I urge you to ask for any clarifications, large and small. Thank you.

THE BEGINNING—

When you were born, the sun, Mercury, and Venus were tightly orbiting through Gemini, happening to fall within your 12th house. When three or more planetary points are in

conjunction it is referred to as a stellium, which I will reference throughout this reading as: your Gemini stellium. A stellium, which is a concentrated amount of energy needing to be conveyed in one main way, through Gemini, however, needing to also be transferred as such through three separate manners of movement, through the sun, through Mercury, and through Venus.

The sun is you, your ego, your character, your light.

Mercury is your mind, your logic, your reasoning, your thoughts, the way you communicate.

Venus is your heart, your love, your passions, your grace, your interests, your talents.

Gemini would definitely be an advanced and auspicious placement for such a stellium for possessing the dream of writing and authorship!

Mercury rules Gemini and is quite comfortable here. Language, writing, communications, journalism, the media, technology, scripts... yes. And traveling... Mercury was the messenger of the gods. He went anywhere he needed to transfer the message. To allow a voice to be heard. Working from anywhere, wouldn't that be a dream!? So yes, I think that your dream is absolutely plausible and possible, as even the 12th house confers that, no, maybe you don't necessarily want or need or desire a limelight, as 12th house endeavors usually want and need privacy, sanctity, seclusion even, so, working behind-the-scenes or simply away from others, quietly, intensely. Doing what needs to be done, even if no one realizes that someone actually does it—does that make sense? That's very 12th house.

Having both the sun and Mercury and Venus here together (your natal sun is at 12° Gemini, Mercury is 15° and Venus is 9°) indicate a defining focus, as well as an interest, talent and excess with all or any of these endeavors.

I like to look in to the degrees, specifically, sometimes, to add further insight into areas requiring specific definition. Venus at 9° Gemini, according to Marc Edmund Jones, who assigned a key word for each degree of the zodiac, assigned PREPARATION to 9° Gemini. I find that very appropriate for you, as much of your chart is either air or earth, but Mars in fire, which can suggest impatience. 12° Gemini represents GROWTH; 15° Gemini represents CLARIFICATION. To me, all of these things will be second-nature to you when working with the word as a profession. You will need to prepare, as well as be quite clear, in an effort to clarify adroitly what you're trying to say. And naturally, growth will inevitably follow after every word.

You have two aspecting connections to your Gemini stellium; Jupiter squares from the 5th house in Virgo and Saturn makes a harmonious trine connection from the 10th house in Aquarius. This suggests to me that, again, writing as a profession should come naturally to you, yet, keep you challenged enough to satiate your Geminian curiosities and interests, as they are likely as spontaneous as they are wide and ever-changing.

Jupiter in your 5th house of livelihood suggests that you will thoroughly evolve, and discover complete joy, through this profession, in a very large way. Virgo is extremely articulate, mastered, and feels it is a duty to be so. (And I just now realized that you are potentially noticing typos and grammatical errors as you read my words! Hahaha) Where Virgo is in your chart is where you feel obligated to serve, such as your writing. You feel pulled to do this. It is your duty, the service you will provide to society. And because Jupiter is here—you will do so in a very big way. Your words shared across the globe, with all types of people, religions, cultures, and tribes. The expanse of your potential and your reach is boundless.

Saturn in your 10th house of professional ambitions tells me that you would rather work for yourself, given the choice; that you prefer to call shots; that you understand your chosen discipline and eagerly accept whatever demands it offers you. Aquarius is a very disciplined sign, offering non-traditional views and beliefs, and preferring independence over instruction. This also makes me wonder if maybe you'll write about off-the-wall type subject matter or human rights, the collective imagination, or even controversial topics in an effort to make a voice be heard.

Also, I would like to mention here that your MidHeaven is in Aquarius, the MidHeaven representing one's greatest ambitions, goals, and potentially—the lesson your soul came here to learn.

I touched upon only quickly above the impatience of Mars in a fire sign. Your natal Mars is in Aries, the most impatient fire sign of the zodiac. However, when I looked up 21° Aries, which is the degree of your Mars, it makes me wonder if your "impatience" is actually expressed through EXERTION rather than impatience, exertion, I'm presuming, by physically and mentally and even perhaps emotionally exhausting yourself through words and thoughts and things that make your head spin?

Mars is Aries ruler, so again, quite comfortable here. In your 11th house of connections, this suggests to me that you are fiercely independent, and expect your friends and acquaintances to be, as well as accept this from you. You are also quite loyal to those who have offered a hand, a heart, or anything at all. And I would imagine that you are rather aggressive in seeking out opportunities, tribes to belong to, even with your hopes and dreams.

You also have a Uranus/Neptune conjunction (17° & 18° respectively) in Capricorn, in your 8th house of needs. When one has these two in conjunction at the time of birth, it represents a very strong pull to fulfill unique gifts with very individualized vision. You are inspired by uncommon things, the newest trends and toys, and possess a very intuitive, keen insight. Again, you are quite independent, and are only waiting for your moment...

In fact, this conjunction is quite rare, and has an opening for possibility only every 171.4 years. You are a part of a celestial movement, if you will, you and those born within this year of you. This conjunction represents a sort of culture all its own. It has been written about

extensively and has been said to be involved with what is being referred to as "the fortunes of civilization," I will include here a small snippet of what I am trying to describe... these meaning any number of four things: ("Cultural Shifts"/ philosopherswheel.com)

- Important creative developments and high peaks of achievement
- Profound effects upon the course of international affairs
- Revolution—though much less drastic
- The challenging and altering of those most dearly held beliefs and ideals

Mars squares this Uranus/Neptune conjunction in your natal chart, telling me that the way you will fulfill these... almost—carnal, primal, life mission-type of urges- is through your 11th house of aspirations. Almost convenient, isn't it? The 11th house represents not only your hopes and dreams, connections to those who can help you achieve them, but also social lifestyles, ideals, values, memberships, activism, broad ambitions, the community, and through relationships with peers. It also magnifies your strength on a collective stance, the discovery that we're not alone in this world, and being wholeheartedly festooned with hope.

The 11th house also offers detachment. Which, for you, is quite nice, as your Gemini stellium is found in the 12th house, you'll want to take all of these experiences and stories and lessons with you to a room by yourself, out of view, out of sight, in order to process and make something of them through words that will be eventually printed.

It is here that you have the urge to take your interests and your investments and your gifts and skills and apply them to a broader audience, a larger world view, boldly enough to expand, to be heard, to share with the world the essence of who you are.

At this point, I would like to interject, too, that the 12th house is also associated with institutions—hospitals, asylums, higher educations, prisons, the Church/monastery, etc... these may be a conduit, an interest, a focus, or a hindrance for you. These privatized sanctions come equipped with privacy mandates and thick, thick walls of secrets and power. Maybe you'll uncover a secret? Or find funding through a grant of higher education to support your efforts or interests?, as Saturn makes a connection to your Gemini 12th house stellium.

Your Gemini stellium was also rising, as your Ascendant falls in Cancer, at 2 degrees. The Ascendant, or Rising, is another term for: the horizon. So, the sun, Mercury, and Venus had just risen and were moving up toward the MidHeaven, which would represent, roughly, noon time on that day, in your birthplace.

When Cancer is on the horizon, the moon is your chart ruler. The moon changes degrees everyday, signs every two or three. The moon governs your emotions, your instincts, your fears, and the way you prefer to be nurtured, the way you nurture those you love.

The moon, your chart ruler, is found in your 1st house of self, at 9* Cancer. Marc Edmund Jones assigned INCLINATION to this degree, allowing me to imagine that you are so inclined to

truly *feel*. Cancer feels. Cancer feels everything. Everything. And as this is occurring in your 1st house, the house which governs you, everything about you, your entire personality, your body, your image, how you feel and think about yourself, your ego, your first impression, your first and natural approach to anything—is felt. It is felt, too, by everyone around you.

Your Ascendant, at 2* Cancer is CONTEMPLATION. I really like that. And I think it's something you do, inherently, effortlessly, unrelentingly. Unapologetically. The Ascendant represents the path your soul was assigned to walk. I like to believe that our souls chose the life we lead, and accepted a mission to follow through and/or lesson to learn (conveyed by your MidHeaven) in each lifetime, and that all of the houses guide us to where we need to be and how we live our lives to accomplish these, while all the signs convey how we go about it all and why. For you, this lifetime will address the second degree of Cancer, through means of your Gemini stellium.

You are a gentle soul, an empath, perhaps. You are also familiar. A sense of security, feeling protected, and, if at all possible, a guarantee are completely necessary for you. Cancer is represented also by the crab, and a crab, in nature, walks sideways rather than forward, and this reflects in a way that describes how one with this rising would approach most anything in life, especially large events or movements that thrust one forward in a dramatic way.

I also would like to point out to you that, though your natal moon is in your 1st house, a more aggressive house, if you will than say, the 12th house, which is where your natal sun and stellium are found, resonates that sense of privacy, that idea of behind-the-scenes unraveling, respite, retreat, and renewal... do you see where I'm going with this? Cancer moon/Cancer rising people need a sense of privacy, a sense of safety, a safe, private place to simply be. And I mean, need this. So, keep this in mind as you travel about, and I'm quite sure you will, and will receive as much nourishment as you can gain from doing so—but do please make sure that as you are abroad that you're always able to go somewhere that is only yours, or somewhere that is familiar, if possible, or to do something, almost ritually, if necessary, to unwind or just be. Does that make sense?

When Cancer is on the horizon, you feel everything, you feel the feelings of others. You may prefer to be independent, but you maintain in inherent connection, a very instinctual connection to your fellow human beings. And may this further guide your words to give voice to those or that which cannot speak, and thank you for needing to do so.

NOW & BEYOND—

PROGRESSIONS—

This was a summary of your natal chart placements, which are set as they are forevermore. I will now move on to your Progressed chart, which works as though every planetary body/point moves one degree per year of your life. As you are 24 years of age, you are to assume everything has moved 24 degrees. Next year, they will move on to the 25th degree beyond where they started. Does this make sense? You most certainly do not have to really know where these are—that's my job! But I can definitely send you an image of your charts, if you would like.

Obviously, the larger planets orbits are just that—larger, and therefore take much more time to move even a degree. So the Progressed chart really only focuses on what the sun, moon, Mercury, Venus and Mars are up to. I will continue with the larger planets, as they convey major life changes, when I explain your Transits next.

Your Gemini stellium has broken apart, as Mercury is much faster moving around the sun than Venus. Your Progressed sun and Venus, however, have moved in to your 1st house, in Cancer, at 6 and 10 degrees, respectively. Your Progressed Mercury is only seconds into Leo in your 3rd house. Your Progressed moon is at 27* Taurus, in your 12th house. And your Progressed Mars is found in Capricorn, in your 11th house, in Aries. Please keep in mind that any reference back to anything should be done with your natal chart. This is simply one method of prediction. All of these placements are therefore: progressed. I will try to indicate so.

To begin with your Progressed chart ruler, again, the moon, your Progressed moon is applying conjunction with your natal Gemini stellium, suggesting that you're culminating a plan as the Progressed moon moves closer and closer to the natal positioning, which would be equivalent to a New Moon, which will occur in a year or two for you.

The Progressed sun and Venus in your 1st house now suggest that you've possibly begun coming out of your shell, perhaps, or coming in to your own, if you consider yourself never really being in a shell, so to speak. Or, this could suggest that you're becoming more and more focused upon yourself, rather than others.

The Progressed Mercury being in Leo now, most dramatically—in only the first few seconds, thereby making this position even more poignant, indicates a flair, a dramatic assertion in how you communicate, associate, interact with others, and vocalize your needs and your wants. I think that this placement is somewhat auspicious of you, as your natal chart lacks—again 'lack' being simply 'as is' rather than 'without'- much natural fire in your chart. Fire emphasizes hope, fearlessness, and assertiveness, and these qualities will definitely assist you in coming along on your way to your goals. Being that this placement falls within your 3rd house of communications, I would think that this could not be more ideal for you. Your Progressed Mercury will move through your natal 3rd house for several years before moving on to your 4th house.

And the Progressed Mars, now in Taurus, implies a determination, nurturance, and love toward all that drives you, motivates you, and makes you feel alive. You may be unwilling to compromise, a bit more stubborn than is usual, and may feel more matter-of-factly drawn to what you want and need rather than so aggressively (fire), or logically (air), or emotionally (water). Mars is the planet that needs movement. In Taurus, movement may feel slower than your natal Mars in Aries would prefer, but do be mindful that you're planting seeds of intention now toward your future and your future investments. This is something that Taurus knows how to do well. Trust this process. Taurus is deliberate. Intentional. Kind. And nurturing. It is in your best interest now to put yourself out there as much as you can in order to plant these seeds wherever you can. And allow. Allow for these seeds to grow. It'll take time. But it will be worth every day of worry/impatience.

I mentioned above the lack of fire—your natal chart consists mostly of earth and air, which represent groundedness, determination, and natural practicality, while also exhibiting curiosity, logical reasoning, and an ability to adapt to any given situation. These truly are gifts to be grateful for (as I lack these in my own). I also mentioned earlier that your natal Mars placement was your only fire, in Aries. Excellent. Truly. Talk about gumption. I do see great things for you.

TRANSITS—

Moving on to transits, which, again, are the placements of this gas giants, referring directly back to your natal chart, concentrating on Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto.

Wherever Jupiter is in our chart is where we will experience expansion, good fortune, opportunity... and Jupiter is in Libra, within your 5th house of livelihood. Here is where I would say—if you can make money by traveling abroad and seeing the world, wow, you'd better take that opportunity!

Transiting Jupiter is opposing your natal Mars in Aries, which is also being consumed in conjunction by transiting Uranus, and will remain so for some time.

Allow me to explain...

When Jupiter opposes Mars, boredom is the least of your worries; you will be very busy roughly until the month of May, will retrograde, and then oppose again until September, however Uranus will have moved on and out of orb.

With this transit, you may experience having more energy than you know what to do with, and freedoms will overwhelm you. It could be hard to say "no" to anything or anyone. This may be the rub, however, in maintaining a certain amount of restraint. Only in consideration to safety measures, such as running yourself too thin or too long, or financing gambles or

whatnot, you know—it would be ill advised to go wild because you're feeling invincible, as this, too shall pass. Otherwise, enjoy!

If you're searching for substance, this transit may not fully provide it, but will offer the conduits *for* opportunities with substance—does that make sense? Use this potential restlessness to go out and grab your dreams. With all of your excess energy, it is good to exercise or some sort of activity otherwise burning the excess in healthy ways. It will not only safely release the excess of energy, but will, too, spark inspiration and insight.

Jumping ahead to Uranus, directly atop your natal Mars, which has been since May 2016, your likelihood in taking risks is higher, which is why I stress in the previous paragraph to maintain a stance with who you are. Well thought out gambles are one thing, but only with intended strategy and forethought. With this transit, overall, is a sense of unexpectedness and unpredictability.

Uranus is the planet of surprise and revolution, awakening and awareness. The changes that you make in your life now will resonate for years to come. Being mindful of this, making good changes will only bring you good things, yes? Uranian transits also, like mentioned previously above in the last paragraph, add a heightened edge of energy, more get-up-and-go, and much more excitement to everything you do. You may feel hella inspired, for no reason at all. But this power you now possess will be quite contagious, others will feel it, notice it, and adore it. They'll want to be a part of it. You will inspire others through both your words and your ways.

Sometimes this transit will arrange circumstances in your life to trigger you to stand up for yourself, to speak out, to assert yourself, confront... possibly needing to make quick decisions, and having really only what you know at this point in your life to be true- to go on. This is a period of much learning. Much absorbing experience. And this is an ideal time in your life to begin. Uranus will conjoin your natal Mars well until March 2017.

Stepping back to Saturn, the planet of discipline and boundaries, and boundless obstacles rewarding opportunity, and Saturn is currently moving in your 6th house of health and duty, in Sagittarius.

I will take this moment in stressing to you that with the two previous transits I just covered, expressing the great rush of adrenalin you may experience, the excess energy, and the surge of inspired electricity potentially affecting your every move—with Saturn in your house of health, it is imperative to take care of yourself and not push yourself further or harder than you're able to tackle, as these two transits are somewhat working against one another in this regard.

With Saturn here, you feel as though you're reaching a make-or-break point, as Saturn noticeably brings issues needing dealt with to the surface. You may need to solve a problem

or find an answer, as you will have an instinct regarding when you need to move on, end something, or otherwise disengage.

Be mindful now of how you're treating yourself, your body, your diet, your mental health. These are all very important. How are you treating your goals? Your intuition? How are you treating your mindfulness? As I mentioned, Saturn brings things to the surface—any mistreatment of yourself and your body could, worse case scenario, surface as illness, exhaustion, dehydration, the like. Take care of yourself is all I'm saying.

With Saturn in this house, too, you may find, as well as it's mixing with Uranus as it is, that the ways in which you would previously do things, go about things... no longer prove effective anymore. This is part of your lesson. That universal nudge we all receive at one point or another in our lives, that urge to go our own way, as they say. To try new things, to find new answers. To begin. It's almost, symbolically, as though the parental Saturn is opening the gate of safety, allowing you to roam on your own. Take it.

Saturn will connect with your natal Mars until September 2017.

Neptune—the planet of inspiration and disillusion- is moving in your 11th house of connections, in Pisces, his comfort zone, as Neptune rules Pisces. He is making a square aspect to your natal Gemini stellium, and will for some time, long in to 2019, each year contacting one of the three of your stellium more intensely. Currently, the emphasis is on Venus, as she is first in line by degree, then the sun, and finally Mercury by 2019. Neptune is also opposing your natal Jupiter, in Virgo, in your 5th house, and will until January 2018.

Allow me to explain...

Neptune beginning its squaring to your natal stellium in Gemini, with Venus, will enhance the sensitivity you may already naturally feel, similar to your natal moon placement in Cancer, as well as your Cancer rising.

Boundaries for anything may be lacking, or, if they're there, you may still not know necessarily how to navigate through. You will likely be quite transparent through this period, and a certain amount of openness is good, healthy even, unless, of course, your need for privacy is not threatened by it. In this case, this transit may be a bit upsetting for you.

Most importantly, through this transit, as you may become "lost" or "foggy" at times, is to know what it is you want, and what it is you do not want, so better to fall back upon when you find yourself in junctions of "lost" or "foggy". Does this make sense?

Again, you're looking for substance. For quality. And Neptune has a way of hiding these, or offering things that glitter, but are not really gold. This is why it is so important to know what it is you're looking for, so that you may notice it when you find it.

This transit also has a way though of guiding you unknowingly to places you didn't think you would appreciate, but will, after all. It has a way of inspiring new ways of looking at things or feeling about things, and you end up, after the transit has passed, in exactly the place you need to be. It's truly a matter of trust with the universe, and with yourself.

Neptune, too, has a way of inspiring sacrifice or pity, that sensitivity I mentioned earlier may work against you should you begin compromising too much of yourself, too much of your time, too much of your heart... this can really wear on you. Be mindful of this. Again, it's about honesty. With yourself, and with those you come in contact with. Transparency. This is what I stand for, and this, I will not. To know yourself. Truly.

And Pluto, the planet of ultimate transformation, is moving through your 8th house of needs, a house where Pluto is most comfortable in fact as Pluto modernly rules Scorpio, which rules the 8th house, and is currently in Capricorn. Pluto is very powerful here. Pluto is conjunct your natal Uranus/Neptune conjunction, and will remain conjoined here for some time, well in to 2018.

When Pluto highlights this kind of conjunction, it simply means that this natal placement will be highlighted in a way that will feel as though it's now awake—does that make sense? Those gifts you received at birth may now be used... have finally found an outlet to show its potential... a celestial green light, if you will. I am guessing that you have these amazing ideas and ideals to share with the world, and now is your chance to share them. Your ideas may possibly be much different than what people are used to, but given this celestial window, now may be a time when folks are more willing to hear what you have to say. There is a certain power, too, with this type of transit, a power that mustn't be tampered with toward any ill doing. It is a gift, a gift to be shared. A gift to be used wisely. Selflessly.

Pluto will also apply toward a square with your natal Mars by February 2017, and then squaring transiting Jupiter in your 5th house by March 2017, creating a t-square energy, the void falling upon your 2nd house of value and worth. This t-square will activate in late March/early April and remain quite healthy until May 2017.

What does this mean? Please take a moment, if necessary, to re-read the previous mentions of your Uranian transit, and know that Pluto will simply be activating this transit in a powerful way. In a transformative way. An evolutionary way. Pluto evokes change, changes to be made that will leave you as a completely different person.

It is truly a very exciting time for you, Christine. I would so enjoy hearing from you about your interests and goals, if you are so inclined. Also, I would be able to more appropriately connect these celestial energies to you, for you.

I have below listed out some of the major transits occurring in the heavens for the next six months, transits I will be posting about on my page on Facebook and through DMAstro, as you

may follow along this way, as well, but below I have attached meaning more personal to YOU as to how these will activate events in your life.

MONTH BY MONTH—

DECEMBER 2016

- Saturn and Uranus are connecting, while Jupiter, too, connects with Uranus and Pluto—refer to the TRANSITS section above
- Jupiter squares with Pluto, which squares Uranus, creating a t-square with the void in Cancer—refer to the TRANSITS section above
- Full Moon at 22* Gemini—this occurs within your 12th house very nearby your Gemini stellium; it may or may not resonate as the degrees are much further apart and out of orb for a conjunction to your stellium. This Full Moon may manifest unconsciously, or subconsciously, teaching more of an internal lesson, a lesson for the soul perhaps. It may provide you with direction, foresight, or even simply an urge to further communicate what you need.
- Mercury is retrograde until January 8—this will occur in your 7th house of relationships and thereby may create miscommunications, misinterpretations over meaning, or all around confusion within your relationships, partnerships, and/or open enemies. It directly opposes your natal moon, so whatever confusion occurs could consequently hit you a little closer to home and heart than it ordinarily would. It could manifest as matters of the heart, specifically, or simply stir your emotional response.
- New Moon at 7* Capricorn—this occurs within your 7th house of relationships, as well as so closely directly opposing your Ascendant; this New Moon event could spark a very real beginning for you, either a relationship, an obvious representation or image you want or need to convey to the world at large, or both! This experience, should you have one, will be very grounding, very real, and quite natural. Again, your natal moon in Cancer may be triggered, and therefore, your emotional well-being affected.

JANUARY 2017

- The t-square remains until mid-month...
- Full Moon at 22* Cancer—this occurs, for you, in your 2nd house of worth and value; too far away in degree to catch your natal moon placement unawares, however, could invoke a

sense of urgency in opposing your natal Uranus/Neptune conjunction. You can reference my writings above, once more, for what that could inspire. Keep in mind that transiting Pluto also opposes this event, so, think: transformation! Renewal! Change!

- Saturn remains connected to both Jupiter and Uranus...
- New Moon at 8* Aquarius—will occur within your 9th house of personal philosophy and horizons while also connecting with your natal Gemini stellium; this event may also stir something within you, depending upon your circumstances at the time. Aquarian energy invites change and a new, fresh, unfamiliar way of looking at things, if even from a detached perspective. Consider this in regard to your natal Gemini stellium.

FEBRUARY 2017

- The Pluto/Jupiter/Uranus t-square reactivates, though Mars conjoins Uranus now... Therefore adding an urgency, an aggression, an excitation, an impatience perhaps. It could also inspire a sense of hope, direction, and confidence.
- Full Moon at 22* Leo—will occur in your 4th house of home as well as triggering your natal Mars as Uranus conjoins, and loosely opposing your natal Saturn, while also squaring natal Pluto; you could feel something here. Close to home, both literally or figuratively. Reference your natal Mars/Uranian transit, which will remind you that change and vitality and energy and the unexpected is to be expected... and as this is a moon event, your natal moon will always be a factor, as it is your chart ruler (and why I am attempting to go into more detail, for you) and emotions could always be stirred. When the moon opposes Saturn, harsh emotions could surface, security issues, specifically, as this occurs within your house of home and inner experiences. Either unresolved matters, or childhood memories... sticking with what you know now could prove to be a better way to navigate yourself through these matters rather than risking or gambling with something new, in an effort to anchor you or help you to feel secure and safe. Try, also, not to agree to any commitments with your emotions. Rely now, rather, on your logical reasoning.
- New Moon at 8* Pisces—occurs for you in your 11th house of connections. Refer back to Neptune, as well as where I explain your 11th house... this New Moon event will trigger your Gemini stellium, furthering any influence Neptune is inspiring, as this event will connect with Neptune for you. This could be a very dreamy time for you, spurred with inspiration and idealism, dreams and good feelings. This could connect, for you, within any of the 11th house representations I mentioned above, be it with or through friendships or considering your hopes and dreams, or through activism or outreach. Or, it could simply

resonate, for you, within, more internally. It is a good time to daydream, to write, to enjoy yourself.

MARCH 2017

- Mars begins to move on, away from the t-square... lessening the intensity listed from February, above.
- Full Moon at 22° Virgo—which will occur in your 5th house of leisure, and may trigger your natal Uranus/Neptune conjunction once more, though, this time from your 5th house, adding the theme of leisure, adventure, risk, even love, romance, or an affair of some sort. The 5th house also involves children, games, celebrations, parties, and joy for the sake of joy.
- Stellium of activity in Aries, including long-time resident Uranus, with the sun, Venus, and Mercury... potentially adding more urgency and/or direction and confidence again by the latter half of the month.
- New Moon at 7° Aries—occurs within your 11th house and squares your Ascendant= new beginning for you. Celestial opportunity. Green light. Begin. Aggressively trailblazing, in search of what you're looking for!

APRIL 2017

- The Pluto/Jupiter/Uranus t-square remains, though with the sun conjoining Uranus in Aries, then t-square dissolves once again...
- Full Moon at 21° Libra—occurring in your 5th house of fun, connecting, too, with transiting Jupiter opposing your 11th house and natal Mars as the sun and Uranus conjoin there. Wow... This could be big. This could trigger adventure or invoke excitement. Be mindful and set intentions.
- New Moon at 6° Taurus—occurring in your 12th house of undoing, making a connection to transiting Jupiter, suggesting again, that this could be something noticeable, as it usually is with Jupiter. However, because it occurs in your 12th house of behind-the-scenes, it could be felt more privately, more inwardly, unconsciously. This is a moon to remind you to be honest with yourself, to be practical, resourceful with what you value, with what you consider worthy of your time, your energy, and your love.

MAY 2017

- Full Moon at 19* Scorpio—occurring in your 6th house of health and duty, on top of your natal Pluto; this may be felt more internally, but may offer a major shift in consciousness, or awareness, in a renewing way. This could be a signal from the heavens to remind you in taking care of yourself, your body, and your overall well-being.
- New Moon at 4* Gemini—occurring in your 12th house on top of your natal Gemini stellium! Crazy, right!? Again, I see this as a new beginning. A new awareness. A new curiosity. A new approach. A new introduction to new ideas, new theories, new new new... This could be a very social event for you, depending where you are in your circumstances. A lot of go, go, go. Conversations. Thoughts. All of these Geminian ideas bursting with fresh eyes.

JUNE 2017

- Full Moon at 19* Sagittarius—occurring in your 6th house of health, opposing your natal Gemini stellium. I would advise following up with last month's Full Moon event in Scorpio, and try to identify anything that jumped out at you at that time in reference to your health, your general well-being, and awareness overall. I would regard this Full Moon even as a follow-up and adjust accordingly, if necessary.
- New Moon at 2* Cancer—occurring DIRECTLY ON YOUR 2* CANCER ASCENDANT! This screams yet another beginning for you, so, if you have yet to begin—NOW! Now is the time. In fact, the powers that be may even force you to do so. However, if you feel as though beginning is all you've been doing up to this point, then perhaps this New Moon event will promote a fresh insight or a new awareness within your beginning. Furthermore, this event will represent a paramount importance, in that so many things you're encountering, experiencing, and feeling are bound to be affected now.

JULY 2017

- Jupiter/sun/Pluto t-square remains quite healthy, joining up with Mars, inspiring more urgency, or, simply a sense of direction and confidence.
- Full Moon at 17* Capricorn—can be found alongside Pluto, on top of your natal Uranus/Neptune conjunction, in your 8th house of needs; this event will not make any other connections to anything in your chart, so, again, it may simply trigger the urge you have in sharing with the world what you have to offer through your gifts, your words, your talents and skills.
- New Moon at 0* Leo—occurring in your 3rd house of communication and will collide in conjunction with transiting Mars and will make absolutely no connections to anything in your natal chart. If anything, set seeds of intention to explore any wants you may have,

especially in terms of the way you communicate, in how you're writing, what you're writing about, perhaps... Leo asks us to express ourselves. If you've lost your voice, for example, this would be an auspicious timing for you in finding it again. If this does not apply to you at this time, try taking an adventure, maybe a road trip. Take a day off. Celebrate yourself, your life, and simply how amazing it is to be alive.
